### HAL WITHIN THE CCSD'S ECOSYSTEM

The CCSD is at the service of the scientific and academic communities. Its mission is to facilitate all forms of direct scientific communication, to give greater visibility to French research through the open dissemination of its results and to ensure its sustainability.

It has created and manages three platforms: HAL, Sciencesconf dedicated to organisers of scientific events, and Episciences for publishing journals. It is a major player of the French National Plans for Open Science (PNSO).

## ONE DEPOSIT, MANY ADVANTAGES

- Easy deposit with the automated processing of metadata from the PDF, the DOI, your identifiers, etc.;
- A single archive for your publications;
- Your publications are quickly visible in your laboratory collection, the portal for your institution, thematic collections, etc.;
- Your publication described by quality metadata to make it easy to find (reference on Google Scholar, etc.);
- A simple solution for sharing your articles, theses, preprints, reports, communications, media, etc.;
- A practice that is consistent with the requests of funding agencies and institutions.

## ONE HAL ACCOUNT THROUGHOUT YOUR CAREER

- An instant CV that can be customised and expanded with the publications you submit to serve as an avatar for your identity as a researcher;
- A data source to complete your ORCID profile;
- A dashboard to monitor your activity (access statistics and downloads of deposits, etc.) and manage your archives (deposit suggestions for automatic import of your open access publications, corrections, versioning, etc.);
- Tools to manage updates and monitoring of your document/ information (library, notifications).

- A vast and diverse range of scientific documents;
- Easy navigation with links between the various archives (authors, affiliations, academic fields, etc.);
